

7. Ticket Terms & Conditions

1. No refunds other than the cancellation of show. This ticket is non – transferable.
2. Artist line up and billed attractions may be subject to change.
3. In order to facilitate the security, safety and comfort of all guests the Licensee reserves the right to refuse admission and refund the ticket value. Please refer to your Fine Guide for Information on articles that will not be allowed onsite.
4. Admission is at Ticket Holders own risk. The Licensee will not be held liable for any loss, injuries or damages sustained at this event including damage, theft or losses to property and motor vehicles, if the cause is due to the negligence of the ticket holder or the unforeseeable actions of other patrons.
5. Duplicate tickets will not be issued for lost or stolen tickets.
6. This ticket is only valid when purchased from official agents. Tickets bought from other sources will be refused admission.
7. Strictly no trading allowed on Festival Site without the Festival's consent.
8. Wristbands removed from wrist or tampered with will be rendered invalid and will not be replaced. Lost or missing wristbands will not be replaced.
9. A condition of sale is ticket holders consenting to being filmed and sound recorded for t.v, video, dvd, webcast and other public broadcast as part of the audience or by onsite CCTV.
